First Presbyterian Church of Sioux City is not a little church. I've been to some churches whose whole buildings could fit within our sanctuary. Members of some other churches can count their active membership with their fingers and toes. And many of my fellow pastors would envy our annual budget.

And yet, like every other church I've heard of, many people want this church to grow. To increase in membership, attendance, and stewardship. With the right spirit, these can be noble goals. And yet I'd still like to encourage people to reflect on the poem "i am a little church" by e. e. cummings.

i am a little church (no great cathedral) far from the splendor and squalor of hurrying cities

cummings was probably describing a small, rural church in New England. And yet cummings' words remind us that, even in a little church, big things happen. God's word is taught. Songs are sung and prayers are lifted up to the Lord. Neighbors in need are helped. Friends gather around tables in fellowship. Babies are baptized. Children become church members. Couples become spouses. The lives of those we've lost are remembered and celebrated.

around me surges a miracle of unceasing birth and glory and death and resurrection:

This church, even when it's not as big as we'd like it to be, is a place where great things happen. Holy things. For everyone who enters, this can be where they experience God's glorious presence, in every act of love and mercy and grace and redemption.

You may have noticed something odd about the poetry of e. e. cummings. cummings' celebration of little churches everywhere is accented by his curious habit of almost never using capital letters, even in his own name. Except for when he refers to God. cummings knew that any church, large or small, has to give priority to the Lord; the One who rules all peoples and places and times.

winter by spring, i lift my diminutive spire to merciful Him Whose only now is forever: standing erect in the deathless truth of His presence

(welcoming humbly His light and proudly His darkness)

By many of the world's standards, our church may not be as great as we'd like it to be. But our influence on the lives of our members and our community can be immeasurable. We continue to stand by people through every birth and confirmation and graduation and marriage and death with them. And our steadfast presence still points to the glory and power of the One we worship, whose presence in our lives and whose truth in our hearts endures forever. We can keep trying to increase in numbers. But it's more important for us to increase in all the ways we represent our God to everyone around us. As long as God's love for all people remains in this church, we will be as great as God needs us to be.
