Friends,

Long after David's death, Acts 13:22 said this:

God said, "I have found David, son of Jesse, to be a man after my heart, who will carry out all my wishes."

Why did God say this? What's so special about David? Why does the Christian church's lectionary calendar dedicate an entire summer of scriptures to him? In short, what was it that made David a man after God's heart?

Yes, David accomplished extraordinary things. As a teenaged shepherd, he killed the giant soldier Goliath. Many of the Psalms are attributed to David, making his words a foundation for some of our faith's most memorable songs and liturgies. And David is renowned for being the greatest king of Israel. But David also had some extraordinary faults. He had one of his most loyal generals killed so that David could marry his widow. And, because of his own sin, he seemed to be unwilling or unable to call out his own children for their own disastrous failings, which almost brought about the end of David's reign.

Yet God accepted this man, with everything that made him both famous and infamous. God took this complex man and still considered him to be a man after God's heart.

But the LORD said to Samuel, 'Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature ... for the LORD does not see as mortals see; they look on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart.' - from 1 Samuel 16:7

Yes, David had spectacular successes and colossal failures. But maybe that's part of what makes David's story speak to us. In David, we see a man who spent much of his life trying to fulfill God's will for himself and for God's people. And all this was in spite of the times when he did what he knew was wrong in God's eyes. In David, we may see someone as imperfect as we can be. And we see that, even with our own faults and failures, we can still love God and love our neighbors. We can still worship and serve. David's story may help us realize that, even in ourselves, God can still see in us another person after God's heart.

In David, we also see a king whose royal line would be fulfilled by the eternal reign of his descendant, Jesus the Messiah. And this, too, should give us hope. Our own lives can end up being a lot more complex than we might want them to be. Yet, in our own worship and service, even we may be able to carry out God's wishes. Like David, any one of us can also end up being a part of Christ's reign on earth.

Your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me; your throne shall be established forever. -2 Samuel 7:16

If you are a member who is willing to drive someone to and from church, please let Karen and/or Kathy know!




## Children's Music
